## Pre-K:

- FOR BOYS ONLY: Men's used solid white button down shirt to be repurposed

## Kindergarten:

# FIRST GRADE

**\*1st Grade Note: We are NOT asking for shoe box plastic bins! This standard item, without cute compartments, will hold all your child's BASIC daily supplies such as markers, scissors, small glue sticks, pencils, etc... If you get packs of supplies that differ from our list, such as the mega pack of colored pencils or markers, your child will struggle with overflow and have harder transitions from subject to subject. Please stick with the specific quantity and specifications listed below. Please separate each list into its own bag and label each item. Thank you!**

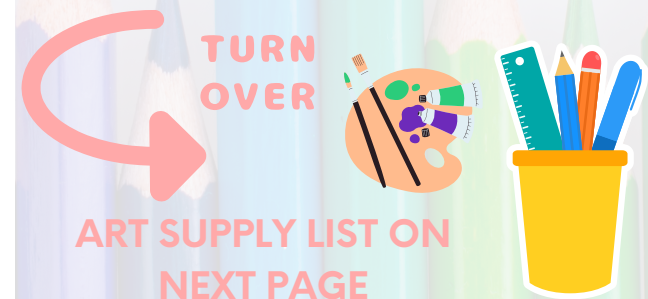
